This will be an easy ride for "beginners" and any one who likes a leisurely ride through gently rolling hills. The ride will mostly be at a walk and will take about 2 hours. We'll have a brief discussion before heading out. During the ride we may trot a little or canter a few strides, if the riders are comfortable.

Sandee will be leading this ride and will not be riding her stallion so she can help other riders with their confidence & horse control. We want everyone to enjoy the ride, the scenery and the camaraderie! With the July heat it's advised to bring a riding helmet or large brimmed hat, sunscreen and water (a camera if you'd like) and a pommel bag to hold it all.



Lunch is "Bring Your Own" Sack Lunch and we'll eat together after the ride. There is NO horse or human water available, so BYO, and there are no restrooms.

Base Camp will be the "Victory Trailhead" parking area located at the very West end of Victory Boulevard in West Hills. The parking area is large with room for many horse trailers.



DIRECTIONS:

From Simi/Moorpark/Thousand Oaks:

Take the 118 east to Topanga, take Topanga to Roscoe and turn Right (West), take Roscoe to Valley Circle and turn Left (South). Take Valley Circle to Victory and turn Right (West). Go to the parking lot at the end.

From Santa Clarita/San Gabriel/ North Valley & Beyond:

Take the 118 west to Topanga, take Topanga to Roscoe and turn Right (West), take Roscoe to Valley Circle and turn Left (South). Take Valley Circle to Victory and turn Right (West). Go to the parking lot at the end.

From Burbank/South SFV and Beyond:

Take 101 West to Mulholland/Valley Circle. Exit and turn Right (North) to Victory and turn Left (West). Go to parking lot at the end.
